### **Rules and Regulations**

- Applications are accepted in the order they are received with full payment. If you cancel you must give 3 weeks'
  notice before the event to receive any refund. Spots will not be assigned without payment in full. This is a rain or
  shine event.
- Describe in detail what items you will be selling for each day. The descriptions provided will be used in news
  releases and promotional advertising for the events and placement. We ask that you do not sell what is not listed
  on this form. All items must be approved by the Taste Committee.
- Setup of all large items must be completed by Friday January 29<sup>th</sup> 2016 between 5-7pm. Small items may be set up the day of the event from 6am-8am. No vehicles will be permitted in the event area after 9:30am. Product will have to be carried to your site.
- No vendor parking is allowed in the Handicap areas.
- Sales or giveaways of beverages are not permitted. This is done by the Kiwanis & organizations working with the Kiwanis Club.
- No space will be assigned without receipt of application and payment. All applications and payments are to be
  received by the Kiwanis Club of Greater Pine Island no later than December 1, 2015. If application is not
  approved, funds will be returned. This event will take place rain or shine. No refunds will be made if
  vendor/exhibitor decides not to participate because of weather.
- Restaurant Vendors will receive 6 Vendor Passes. All other categories will receive 4 passes; if additional passes are needed they must be purchased at the main gate.
- Vendors and exhibitors must supply their own extension cords, hoses, fire extinguishers, tents, tie downs, weights, etc.
- The Kiwanis Club of Greater Pine Island will not be responsible for vendor complying with State Sales Tax Laws.
- Vendors will receive via email the site map and assigned number the week prior to the event.
- Do not move your assigned site or move items from other sites.
- No vendor is permitted to remove any item not belonging to them from the property.
